- REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK - I Kings 17:1-4

The Prophet and the Raven

The Law was given to Moses, in Lev 11:13-15, "And these are they which ye shall have in abomination among the fowls; they shall not be eaten, they are an abomination: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the ospray, And the vulture, and the kite after his kind; Every raven after his kind;" The raven is a scavenger and considered unclean. Yet in this text, one of the greatest prophets was asked to take food given by a raven.

Some may question why the raven. Understand this, God moves in mysterious ways. So, with further investigation, a Raven is a resourceful bird, which stores food. So, the prophet could be fed in a time of scarce food. God's sovereignty is conveyed over everything, even an unclean bird. But allow me to say; "What God hath cleansed, that call not thou common." (Acts 10:15). Elijah was instructed to go eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, And the ravens brought him (Elijah) bread and flesh in the morning, and bread and flesh in the evening; and he drank of the brook.

After some time, the brook dried up, because there was no rain in the land. Elijah then was ordered by God to go to the city of Zarephath, where God had commanded a widow woman there to sustain Elijah, and Elijah arose and went.

This text conveys the power of God, over every element, even the raven, "And the word of the Lord came unto him, saying, Get thee hence, and turn thee eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan. And it shall be, that thou shalt drink of the brook; and I have commanded the ravens to feed thee there." (verses 2-4).

Do you fully understand, the Power of God, the omnipotent of God; commanded the ravens, to feed Elijah. Mark 4:41b, says; "What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?" Even though the Raven was declared as unclean.

REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK (CON'T)

The scripture says in Leviticus 11:2a; 13-15 "Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, And these are they which ye shall have in abomination among the fowls; they shall not be eaten, they are an abomination: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the ospray, And the vulture, and the kite after his kind;"

Then the question would be, why did the Lord choose a raven to feed Elijah? The answer is because the Lord is God, who has dominion and power, both now and forever.

Even though a Raven brought food to the prophet, the scripture says; "For every creature of God is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving: For it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer." (I Timothy 4:4-5).
