# - REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK - Black History

**Galatians 3:28** 

Black History had its genesis (beginnings) in 1915. When Carter G. Woodson founded the Assoc. to promote and educate people of the negro race. Woodson envisioned a weeklong week, through the "Association for the Study of African American Life and History." His desire was to broaden the nation's consciousness of the Negro in America and their contributions to the growth of America. President Gerald Ford officially recognized Black History Month in 1976, calling upon the public to seize the opportunity to honor the neglected accomplishments of the Negros in America. The struggle for recognition is still struggling hard today. Some say we've come a long way, yet we know we have a long way to go.

One of the most challenging tasks for our race is the great need to educate our descendants, who to this day are falling behind in America's way of life. Unless our descendants see the importance of education and preparation, we as a race will continue to fall behind in America.
