# - REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK - Acts 9:10-19

### **Ananias, a Praying Man**

The scriptures mention three named Ananias. There was Ananias, the husband of Sapphira, who held back some of the money made from a sale, (Acts 5:1-6). A man named Ananias, a high priest, was president of the Jewish court known as the Sanhedrin. And then it was this Ananias, a praying man who lives in the city of Damascus. There is not much written in the scripture regarding this Ananias. However, I've concluded, that this Ananias was a man who prayed unto God often. Luke 18:1 says; "men ought always to pray, and not to faint;"

It was on one of Ananias's prayer times when the Lord appeared to Ananias in a vision, saying; "Arise, and go into the street which is called Straight, and enquire in the house of Judas for one called Saul, of Tarsus: for, behold, he prayeth, And hath seen in a vision a man named Ananias coming in, and putting his hand on him, that he might receive his sight. Then Ananias answered, Lord, I have heard by many of this man, how much evil he hath done to thy saints at Jerusalem: And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name." (Acts 9:11-14).

But, the Lord said unto him (Ananias) "Go thy way: for he is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel:" Upon receiving this from the Lord, Ananias "went his way, and entered into the house; and putting his hands on him said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that thou mightest receive thy sight, and be filled with the Holy Ghost." (Acts 9:17). The scripture says "immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sigh"

you may be, God can and will use you if your communication has been vertical unto the Lord. This man was a praying man who prayed often and on this day, the Lord gave him an assignment: Go into the city of Damascus, where Saul of Tarsus was praying, and lay hands upon him that he may receive his sight.

This praying man, to my knowledge never wrote a book, preached a message, taught a class, or attended college. Yet god used this man to lay his hands upon to receive sight. Saul of Tarsus, went forth on his missionary journey, establishing churches, writing epistles, and teaching nations, and countries. And it all started with Ananias the praying man, who prayed often.
