— REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN’S DESK —

Ezra 1:1-5

The Building of a Nation

In building a nation, it takes many faithful hands to be involved. Upon the decree of Cyrus, the Persian King, whom the Lord stirred up his heart stated; *“The Lord God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah.”* (Ezra 1:2). The people of God were defeated, because of their gross disobedience. From the prophecy of Jeremiah, who wrote; *“the Lord said unto me, A conspiracy is found among the men of Judah, and among the inhabitants of Jerusalem. They are turned back to the iniquities of their forefathers, which refused to hear my words; and they went after other gods to serve them: Therefore thus saith the Lord, Behold, I will bring evil upon them, which they shall not be able to escape; and though they shall cry unto me, I will not hearken unto them.”* (Jeremiah 11:9-10a; 11).

God moves in mysterious ways, would be correct. For the nation of Judah to be built, the people of God, who had been captured. To rebuild a nation, they needed a king who would assist them.

The Lord anointed Cyrus King of Persia saying; *“That saith of Cyrus, He is my shepherd, and shall perform all my pleasure: even saying to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be built; and to the temple, Thy foundation shall be laid.”* (Isaiah 44:28). From Cyrus’s mouth said; *“The Lord God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah”* (Ezra 1:2).

There were two main facets, that had to be done. First, this was given to Ezra and Nehemiah.

Ezra was to head up the religious part of the nation. The scripture says; *“Ezra went up from Babylon; and he was a ready scribe in the law of Moses, which the Lord God of Israel had given: and the king granted him all his request, according to the hand of the Lord his God”* (Ezra 7:6). *“And a letter unto Asaph the keeper of king’s*

forest, that he may give me timber to make beams for the gates of the palace which appertained to the house, and for the wall of the city, and for the house that I shall enter into. And the king granted me, according to the good hand of my God upon me.” (Nehemiah 2:8).

Second, Zerubbabel, Jeshua, Nehemiah, Seraiah, and others were all instrumental in the building of a nation. Bring again into the ears and hearts of the people the worship of God. Allow me to say that no nation can be successful without God not being present. Also, they had to have a people who had the heart to build a nation, and today we have the proof. The nation is built by the Grace of God.
