# - REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK - Ruth 1:1-4

### Commitment

Commitment is a pledge of obligation. To be committed, a person must experience a cause to be engaged. This text provides some examples. Famine arose in Judah, which caused some to travel to where employment could be obtained. A man named Elimelech, whose wife by the name of Naomi migrated to the country of Moab, where employment was. They and their two sons Mahlon and Chilion traveled with them. As this family settled in Moab, tragedy came. Elimelech the husband, and father died, leaving Naomi to be a widow. As the sons grew to be adults, they both took wives of the women of Moab, named Orpah and Ruth. They were married for ten years, and tragedy struck again. Mahlon and Chilion died also, leaving Naomi, and the wives without their men.

This tragedy left the women, under dreadful circumstances. No men, no husbands to earn a living. Naomi had no choice, but to return to her country in Judah. With Naomi's daughters-in-law being Moabites. Naomi said unto the daughters-in-law to return to their homes in Moab and prayed that the Lord would deal kindly with them.

Naomi kissed her daughters-in-law, and they all cried. And they said unto Naomi, "Surely we will return with thee unto thy people. And Naomi said, Turn again, my daughters: why will ye go with me? are there yet any more sons in my womb, that they may be your husbands? Turn again, my daughters, go your way;" and again they all lifted up their voices, and wept.

As they were deciding what to do. Orpah kissed her mother-in-law; but Ruth clave unto her mother-in-law Naomi. Ruth, however, entreated her not to leave her, and said these committed words; "for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people shall be my people, and thy God my God: Where thou diest, will I die, and there will I be buried: the Lord do so to me, and more also, if ought

but death part thee and me."

In this text, we see two commitments, one commitment, went so far, and the other commitment forever. We find these two views of commitment, among some spirit-filled saints. Some are filled with the Holy Spirit, and committed to stay saved, spirit-filled unto the end of time. Where other's commitment is not as concrete, and they decide to return to the world or be less committed.

To be completely filled with the Holy Ghost, we need to be fully committed. The apostle Paul, maybe said, how a committed person is committed; "I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus." (Acts 21:13b).
