- REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK -Ephesians 2:2-3 In Time Past

Before being born again of the water and the Spirit, evidenced by speaking in tongues, our heavenly word, we did what the world told us to do, without reservation, fulfilling the desires of the flesh according to the prince of the power of the air and walking in what the flesh dictated. In the past, we were stone sinners, and sinning became our nature. But God! Who is rich in mercy, and Christ's great love wherewith he loved us, enabled us to find his grace. *"For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:"* (Ephesians 2:8). Always remember by blood, and grace of God let the past be the past.

To stay delivered from our past, commit ourselves to be God's workmen, who are created in Christ Jesus.

By the grace of God allow yourself to grow into the servants God has called out the darkness into his marvelous light. Cities that are set on a hill which, cannot be hidden. Our past will never catch up with us when we stay anchored in Christ Jesus; *"Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new."* (II Cor. 5:17).

In Christ Jesus, we the workmen of Jesus Christ, are lights shining in the midst of darkness.

As we leave the past behind us, never to be resurrected again, by being the new creation in Christ Jesus.

As the apostle Paul has written in many of his writings, has written, we present our bodies as a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God which is your reasonable service, unto God. Our past will tug on us to return to our past, but we must submit ourselves unto God, which is only our reasonable service, therefore our flesh will require to be mortified, put to death, through prayer and fasting.

REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK (CON'T)

The writer King Solomon wrote; *"To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:"* (Ecc. 3:1). This passage of King Solomon explains that there will be in born-again spirit-filled saints, to be tempted at times of time past. But by submitting ourselves to God we are able to resist the devil, our flesh from reverting back to time past. As it reads in Hebrews 4:15-16 *"For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin."*. So, as spirit-filled saints of God, we can *"come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need."*
