**— REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN’S DESK —**  
**Black History**

**Ephesians 6:8**

Black History explains itself. Black History, or recognition of the Blacks in America, what have they meant to the growth or contribution to America. Blacks who have plowed the fields, picked the cotton and tobacco on the farms, and mixed the cement for our skyscrapers' buildings. Who have worked in the hot steel mills to build the buildings that rise out of our cities. Many black mothers have raised, the majority's children and have cooked and cleaned their homes.

Yes, Black History should be recognized, because for many years it has been hidden by the majority, only to creep from the loose soil to full growth. We as Blacks have come a long way, but we still have a long way to go. Our young, gifted blacks are not being given the recognition they should have. We Blacks are more than the six o'clock news, we are more than those who can hit the baseballs for home runs. Or run faster than anyone in the world. By way of the Olympics, and world-side events.

In the early fifties, we marched, sat in, and boycotted, to bring equality for the Blacks in America. Let's march for the history and legacy of our race. Saying, let's promote pride and accomplishments of being successful in whatever we do. As Blacks, we are responsible for teaching our young, from the cradle to the grave. It's not the majority's job to educate our blacks on how proud it is to be black. I can say as a black man, we have done a miserable job in educating our young on being black.

## REFLECTIONS FROM BISHOP JORDAN'S DESK (CON'T)

As Black's we should wing ourselves from the government to help out with hand-outs. And oh yes, those welfare checks you receive, it is not to help you, it's to keep the blacks in bondage.

It's time for our wealthy Black Americans, to start investing in you, knowledge, and money to give a hand-up not have them in the hand-out lines of the government. It won't be easy, but we can do it. As a person, I enjoy watching the series, "Ice Below Zero." In one season the Eskimo man was teaching his infant son the native tongue of the Eskimo. The pride of the Eskimo is how they learn to survive in the fifty-, or lower-degree temperatures.

This man was proud to be an Eskimo, and I say it is time for us Blacks to be proud of who we are and train up our children to be proud of who they are. Regardless of whether it is Black History Month or not.
